

Participation Conditions for Deutscher Planspielpreis 2011 (German Simulation and Gaming Award)

Summary

The Zentrum für Managementsimulation (ZMS) Stuttgart (Centre of Management Simulation) in cooperation with SAGSAGA awards excellent scientific theses concerning “Simulation and Gaming” with the Deutscher Planspielpreis (German Simulation and Gaming Award). The purpose is to advance theory and practice of “Simulation and Gaming”. An application is possible with a final thesis of academic studies. There is also a special prize for Doctoral thesis, Dissertation or Habilitation.

How to participate

- Application is possible with a thesis in form of Diploma, Bachelor, Master and Graduate etc. or with a Doctoral thesis, Dissertation or Habilitation.
- The thesis has to discuss a theme concerning „Simulation and Gaming“.
- The thesis has to be written in German or English.
- The thesis must be submitted to a European University since 2008/01/01.
- You may not submit a thesis for Deutscher Planspielpreis (German Simulation and Gaming Award) for a second time.
- Group, project or seminar theses that are not final theses cannot be submitted.
- Theses can be submitted by third person. In this case the author’s sign has to be given on the form.
- Members of the ZMS or the jury are excluded of participation.

What we need

- Print and electronic version (PDF-Format) of the thesis.
- In addition a written abstract in print and electronic version (three pages maximum, five pages maximum for the special prize) including keynotes and results of the thesis.
- The filled out and signed form.
- All documents have to be submitted up to 2011/05/16 and remain at the ZMS.

How to be evaluated

- Our jury consists of representatives of interdisciplinary science and practice.
- Evaluation is based on the general accepted academic guidelines.
- Evaluation is not public and the decision is final.
- The awardees are to be informed in written form after the decision (at least three weeks before award ceremony).

The prize

- The best three theses will be awarded; there is also a special prize for Doctoral thesis, Dissertation or Habilitation.
- The prize includes a certificate, a prize money and a free of charge membership in SAGSAGA for two years. The awardee is also invited to the Zukunft Personal 2011 in Cologne to the award ceremony on 2011/09/20. There the awardee gets the opportunity to present his thesis. We also plan to publish outstanding papers.
- The prize money for the first place is 1.000 €, second place 750 € and third place 500 €. The special prize is 1.000 €.

Some more details

- With submission the candidate accepts that
 - The thesis and bibliography will be collected in a list that will be published
 - Information of the awarded theses and of the awards ceremony (incl. photos) may be published.
 - The submitted abstract of awarded theses can be published on the websites of the ZMS and SAGSAGA in due form.
- Any recourse to courts of law is excluded.
- The candidate is responsible that the thesis doesn't contain information which must not be disclosed to third parties.
- With his application the candidate agrees with these conditions.
