And I was able to see and enjoy Stuttgart a lot through welcome week held in the first week. I'm so grateful because those are still the most memorable moments for me.

LIFE IN YOUR HOST COUNTRY

Was it difficult to find your way in the host country? What surprised you the most?

At first, I was embarrassed because I didn't know that all stores (including marts) were closed on Sunday, so there was nothing to eat. And at first, it was complicated to take the subway, but it got better over time. Except for these, there were no other difficulties. I was worried because I couldn't speak German, but there was no problem because many people spoke English.

Which experience do you remember particularly well?

As written above, the most memorable thing is to experience the Stuttgart area with Buddy during welcome week. The moments when I went to Beer Garden and famous tourist attractions with my friends from various countries and Buddy who know this area well are so precious.

And also, Stuttgart is in a very good position to travel to other European regions, so it is memorable to travel to many regions with low transportation costs.

What advice would you give other scholarship holders coming to this host country?

Thankfully, BWS gave us a scholarship, so it would be nice to have various experiences like traveling or learning something. And although I couldn't participate, I recommend going to many meetings held at BWS because it will help you have a more diverse experience.

The most anticipated thing was to meet many people from various countries and to travel a lot and gain experience. I think I've achieved that goal.
